Profile

Simon Bussiere is an Assistant Professor in the School of Architecture at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa. His practice and research in design, representation and pedagogy have been published widely.

Bussiere's professional experience spans the environmental design spectrum. At EDAW/AECOM in Melbourne Australia, his work included conceptual and schematic design for E-Gate, a proposed multi-billion dollar, 6,000 resident, zero-carbon "eco-district", along with a range of complex local and international work in corporate, leisure, cultural, real estate development, civic, utilities, and transportation market sectors. While at AECOM, Simon was a member of the global team that won first prize in the international design competition for Seoul Grand Park in 2009. As creative director at LANDMASS, a collaborative research and design/build laboratory (formerly nativespace), Simon has directed the planning, design, and construction of numerous projects from inception through to implementation and administration. With expertise in conceptual design, visualization and community engagement, he is an active design leader on a range of local and international projects across a wide range of scales and complexity. He is currently the Vice-President of the American Society of Landscape Architects Hawai'i Chapter.

Bussiere earned his professional degree in landscape architecture at the University of Massachusetts in Amherst and later his post-professional graduate degree at Harvard University where he focused on international projects in landscape, architecture and urbanism. While at the Graduate School of Design at Harvard he designed projects in India, Brazil, Costa Rica, Sardinia and Nicaragua, where he was awarded a GSD Studioworks selection by architect Teddy Cruz and an International Community Service Fellowship for his collaborative work in the peri-urban community of La Prusia, Nicaragua. Professor Bussiere currently teaches a range of courses with a focus on ecological urban design at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa. He advises student research, serves on numerous departmental, college, university and professional committees in Honolulu, and contributes regularly as a writing and design reviewer for professional and academic organizations around the globe.
